Learn about the gorilla's conservation story and come face-to-face with our primate cousins in their natural habitat. Rwanda is one of only three countries in the world where you can see these gentle giants. A cheaper option to gorilla trekking, discover the playful and inquisitive nature of the golden monkey, a beautiful little creature found only in the high-altitude forests of the Volcanoes National Park. Spend the morning searching the lush vegetation at the foot of Mount Sabyinyo for one of two habituated groups of the golden monkey, one of them a troop of more than 80 members.
